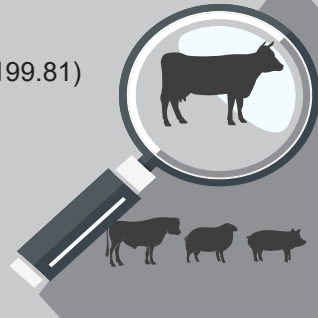

## CATTLE



A better show of numbers and a handy yarding of bulls forward, with more bulls wanted each week. With a fresh ringside face and further ringside account opening up, it has shown that the constant freefall of finished cattle prices over the previous 2 months may have reached its end.

### Prime Steers -

Still a mixed yard in terms of quality, with top today from PC Amor who saw Simmental bullocks to 341p/kg with the same home to 340p/kg. Freeman farming saw South Devon steers to 339p/kg, with R & T Reeve to 336p/kg for weight. Heavyweight Angus from Edward Hull saw 329p/kg with Blues from the same stable to 320p/kg.

Top grossing steers saw Blues from Ed Hull to £2476, with R & T Reeve selling to £2423 for Herefords. The Hull stable saw Angus to £2414 with Devons from Freeman Farming to £2305.

### Prime Heifers -

Top heifers today saw handy weighted Limousins from Ed Hull to 360p/kg, with the same home selling to 340p/kg for well finished dairy bred Blues with another from the same stable to 335p/kg.

No real weight to speak of in the heifers today, but a top of £2070 from the Hull stable for handy weighted Limousin heifers.

### Prime Bulls -

More are wanted every week!

A fantastic show of bulls forward, with a top of 400p/kg on two occasions from Honesberie Farms, with a further bull from the same stable to 397p/kg. PC Amor sold to 374p/kg, with the same stable to 366p/kg matching Blues from Graham Potter.

Black and white bulls a tidy trade, selling to 285p/kg from GE Thompson, with the majority trading 270-280p/kg.

Top grossing bulls from Honesberie selling to £2636 for Limousins with the same stable selling to £2624, ahead of PC Amor at £2550 for Blues.

### Cows -

A bumper yarding and more could definitely be sold. If you have cull cows to market of any size or shape please feel free to contact a member of the team.

Top today saw heavyweight slips from Ted Taylor selling to 292p/kg with RW Cross seeing thick meated Limousin cows to 275p/kg. Angus from Gordon Stretton sold to 260p/kg.

Top grossing cow from the Taylor stable saw Simmentals to £2616 with RW Cross to £2161.

## LAMBS 1769 FORWARD

SQQ 472.42P/KG AVG £199.81 TOP £255.50

A good yarding but a few booked in not forwards following the morning deluges at around 8am. Those forwards though in massive demand and a ring full of buyers. Simply mad and despite the exact date being the usual annual mass slow in the trade a trade that saw a massive return throughout with Export Lambs trading well over 940p/kgdw and heavies trading at rates never before seen.

Lambs a real trade and best lambs to 518p/kg for the first in the ring from J Herod with DS & LE Wadland 40 to 43kg at 516 and 513p/kg, whilst our youngest Vendor MISS ARABELLA MORRIS sold just in time for her third birthday with 38kg at 513p/kg selling to Euro Quality Lamb Ltd. Today finished lambs with shape regularly 480p/kg mark with shape but lesser finish 470=480p/kg and lean grass lambs 440 to 450p/kg to give an SQQ of 472p/kg and an all through avg of £199.80!

Weighted Lambs a very fast trade selling to 491p/kg at 47kg from J & R Lowe with J Baker & Sons 46kg at 487p/kg HS Underwood & Son 46.5kg 486p/kg. Heavies even trading at 470p/kg plus for meat. Today MM Clarke & Sons selling a wagon full of 183 Labs at 45.5kg to return £214.30. A run full of meat reaping the rewards!

In the lump Export lambs to £222 for DS & LE Wadland for 43kg at H S Underwood & Son 43kg at £220. MG & SM Grindal 43 & 43kg at £218 with PM Jarrom. Plenty of Exports today passing well over the £200 mark. Heavies though the real story for the day today and in massive demand with new buyers upsetting the apple cart and the gap left by the Hogg trade struggling to be breached. Top for the day a massive £255.50 for loyal local supporter Jo Webster at 58.5kg with H S Underwood & Son £253 at 56kg with RW Harrison & Sons 51.5kg at £246 equal with J & R Lowe and MM Clarke & Sons x3. Lamb trade continues to fly along. Meat though is key and with the rise in weighted demand buyers are encouraged to feed Lambs. Feed has seen little appreciation in recent years and looks very cost effective.

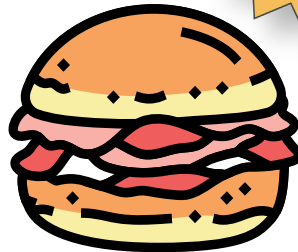
