## CATTLE



A fresh face at ringside saw two further buying accounts opening up at ringside. Trade on the whole firmer, with bulls remaining the easiest sold.

### Prime Steers -

Shorter show of steers today saw Ed Hull selling to 397p/kg with weight from the same stable selling to 344p/kg. Top grossing bullock today for heavyweight Limousins selling to £2504 from the Hull stable.

### Prime Heifers -

Some corking heifers on offer, soaring to 406p/kg for an extreme Limousin from Ed Hull with weight from GR Fontaine selling to 356p/kg, ahead of Blues from Ed Hull selling to 344p/kg.

Top grossing heifers from GR Fontaine selling to £2541 for heavyweight Limousins, with Ed Hull selling to £2379 and £2297.

### Prime Bulls -

Bulls remaining a real trade, with Honesberie Limousins selling to a top of 400p/kg, with the same home soaring to 394p/kg and 389p/kg. Ed Hull saw dairy bred Limousins to 325p/kg, with heavyweight Blues to 302p/kg. Black and Whites from George Thompson sold to 270p/kg, with others to 266p/kg.

Top grossing bull from Honesberie sold to £2896, with the same stable to £2694 and £2668.

Seasonal Store Cattle entries but numbers now I demand as the National supply level has now been tested and the Fat ceases to fall. MORE STORES NEEDED

Starting with the Cows we saw another trance from WS Harrison & Sons sell Angus to £2700 for 2023 Cows with March Steer Calf at foot. Others to £2450 with heifers at foot.

Store Cattle seeing a £150 raise on the week and R D Badham sold a run of Bucket sorts to a trade more akin to what we had seen in March. Stabiliser Heifers 11m to £1185 and Angus Steers all very much Bucket sorts to £1080. GR Kerr next from Daventry at a real shot. Seeing hard done Beef Shorthorn to £1310 for 11m Steers with Heifers to £1260. Star of the show JS Agricultural Services saw a massive enquiry for his warn stores out of Monty Cows sold to £2000 for 14-16m Steers others £1950, £1910 and £1890. Hereford Heifers from the same £1740 at 14m. A serious trade throughout with the travelling buyers taking control today.

## LAMBS 1983 FORWARD

SQQ 438.17P/KG AVG £184 TOP £266.50

Another new face around the ring. Trade hitting the seasonal barriers and speaking to the Whoelsalers trade hitting a slump and shop counters quiet. A yard full of lightweight grass lambs coming forward and rightly so with vendors looking to cash in that said we found just shy of 2000 today whilst other Centres saw less and maybe Supply will tighten at the perfect time. 39kg to 41kg now over supplied nationally with very small very dear still and weighted lambs a flying trade. As to prove the point the avg of over 45kg lambs today greater than the SQQ of 437p/kg. Meat fed lambs still well sold and looking to make great returns and 460p/kg plus no barrier for fed Lambs. Grass lambs though short on finish trading 415p/kg to 425p/kg and with a short audience. Best lambs easiest sold and 500p/kg hit by GR Fountaine & Son at 40kg for Beltex with MM Clarke & Sons 41kg at 498p/kg and J & R Lowe 45kg to 493p/kg. Harrison Bros, Calverton lightweight Beltex 35kg at 491p/kg and 44kg from GR Fountaine & Son, Buckingham the same. A wealth of meat lambs over 460p/kg if fed. Heavies a different story and trading at extreme rates still topping at 479p/kg at 48kg from J & R Lowe whom sold 50kg at 478p/kg also. S Wright with Blue Texels to 472p/kg at 47kg with MM Clarke & Sons 50kg at 470p/kg.

An all in Avg of £184 a fast return still and skewed by a large number of lightweights forwards. Exports though topping at £222 for 45kg from J & R Lowe with GR Fountaine & Son 44kg at £216 and Messrs Lowe and MM Clarke & Sons £215 at 45kg. Plenty of Export weights still breaking £190.

Overall a massive top price of £266.50 for MM Clarke & Sons at 58kg with the family of feeders also 53kg at £247 and 55kg at £244.50. A V Boffey 53kg at £242.50 and J & R Lowe 52kg at £240 equal with WJ Pearson & Son.

Trade still very favourable albeit with feeding now really will pay. Heavy shortfall likely to remain and vendors encouraged to ensure finish on lambs.
