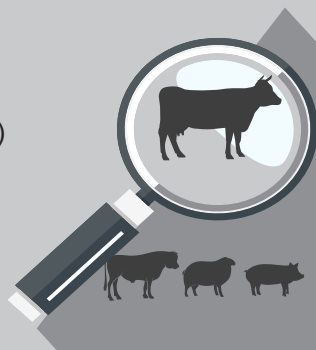

A short show and more clean cattle wanted to meet buyer demand. Bulls a sharp trade with buyers wanting bulls.

Steers -

A short show of steers saw GR Fountaine with Angus to 351p/kg, ahead of HC & HW Farming selling Angus to 324p/kg. Top grossing steers from the Fountaines selling to £2485 for Angus with HC & HW Farming selling to £2326.

Heifers -

Top heifer today also from the Fountaine stable selling to 370p/kg, with R & T Reeve selling to 337p/kg, with 3 Blue heifers from the Jarroms trading at 330p/kg.

Top grossing heifers from R & T Reeve selling to £2298 for Blondes, with Limousins from the Fountaines to £2153. Dairy bred Blue heifers from Pete Jarrom sold to £1862.

Bulls -

LAMBS;

Equal number on the week and a yarding of two differing commodities. Those lambs pushed hard on the feed and not yet become stale very strong and thriving in the weather the other end saw grass lambs that seem to be taking harm in the heat and very short on meat.

Trade slipping towards the end of last week with Exports on a go slow as Europe is hit by the heat wave. Plenty of buyers around ringside but all operating on limited number orders. AN SQQ of 383p/kg a marked rise on the end of the week and a deadweight equivalent just shy of £8 per kg/dw.

Best end lambs seeing a lift in demand with best sorts dearer on the week and a top today of 451p/kg for W Bartlett with Beltex lambs at 39.5kg and others at 447p/kg and LG Russell & Son, Startford Upon Avon 444p/kg for lightweight shape equal with GR Fountaine & Son. Meat with shape today all over 410p/kg. Run of the Mill export meat 370p/kg plus with leaner hard done lambs 350p/kg and upwards with limited buyers for lean lambs and some taken to feed again. Weight on the other hand a serious trade throughout and feeding paying dividends. Meat lambs in massive demand with weight shape and meat from SM Ellingworth, Market Harborough at 50kg selling to 450p/kg with EJ Taylor & Son 49KG AT 449p/kg and Amy Wright Dutch spotted 58kg at 445p/kg. J Baker & Son, Lutterworth 443p/kg. Meated weight lambs all over 420p/kg unless short of meat. All in avg today £170 seeing Export lambs to £190 for PD & DM Hopcraft at 45kg with the same selling 44kg at £184 and Leadbeater Services 45kg at £183. Plenty of Export lambs £180.

Overall a top today of a massive £259.50 at 62kg for HS Underwood & Son with Amy Wright 58kg at £258 and BJ & IS Wain £250. J Baker & Sons £248 at 56kg, Ted Taylor 55kg at £246 and RJ White, Todenham 56kg Suffolks to £240.

Export trade held up by the weather and also a wealth of lambs coming onto the market. Meat is key

Short numbers but a most serious trade with buyers two deep and all firing. A massive trade for the medium weights on show.

Top for shape today £250 and £238 for G R Fountaine for shape medium weight Texels. E Brain & Son £230 and TM Paton & Son £225. Continentals with weight or shape over £210 and medium ewes easily £6 per kg and often £15 dearer than expected. Suffolks to a top of £235 and £232 for Minshull Farms Ltd with £229 for EJ Taylor & Son. Suffolks with weight all flying past £200.

Medium weight of all grades the dearest per kg throughout.

Mues to a top of £196 for Welsh from RJ Wright and NCM £184 for H Hunt & Son up the M40. Mules a real trade today with even medium weight Mules passing £150 and looking a serious trade.

Ewes should not miss this trade with a long time until the next Festival
