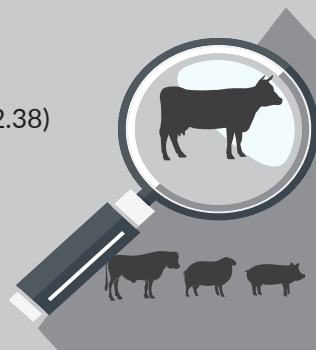

Prime Cattle -

An entry that can only be described as mixed. With the majority of clean cattle overage and the bulls a mismatch, trade on paper would not look just as sharp but in truth looking just as dear as previous weeks given the show on offer.

Steers topping at 319p/kg for 31 month old Blue steers from Avon Blue with WJ Russell selling to 310p/kg for Simmentals with the same home to 309p/kg. R & T Reeve saw heavyweight Limousins to 300p/kg.

Top grossing steers saw Limousins to £2472 for heavyweights from R & T Reeve with Angus Russell to £2213 and £2163 for Limousins.

41 month Angus steers sold to £1873 with the same stable seeing £1767 for overage Blues.

Bulls a firm trade for the goods on offer. Herefords from the Reeves to 319p/kg with Angus from the same stable to 317p/kg. Blues from Avon Blue sold to 280p/kg with GE Thompson seeing Black and Whites to 279p/kg.

Top grossing bulls saw Avon Blue with OTM bulls to £2166, and R & T Reeve selling to £2098 for Angus.

More cattle of all sizes and shapes are wanted desperately. Finished Clean and Bulls, fed cows as well as untested store cattle and feeding cows.

LAMBS 2046 FORWARD

SQQ 360P/KG AVG £162.38 TOP £246

Lambs;

Summer holidays, hot weather and lean lambs all combining to depress the trade and most significantly the Export weights. Morning reports and the end of last week seeing averages drop into the 340p/kg mark meant a day when everyone feared for short term returns. Thankfully our buyer strength showed up and the 2001 Lambs sold and seen returned an SQQ of 360p/kg albeit no firms hungry for numbers. A two tier trade throughout the nation. Fed lambs trading 40p/kg ahead of the lean grass types that are now out in force Nationally. Lean lambs starting to bring down the trade as fridges remain with unsold lean lambs. Alive they are worth gold and dead they must be sold!!

Export Lambs topping at 419p/kg for D Bennett over from Uttoxeter at 43kg with DS & L Wadland 45kg at 409p/kg. Staffordshire finest 45kg at 407p/kg with BJ & I Wain 35kg at 406p/kg. Fed Exports 380-440p/kg with leaner lambs 345-360p/kg and very lean 330 plus. Again those lambs 44-45kg in general 10p disadvantage. Meat easily 50p/kg premium. Weight still easiest sold and plenty of weight over 400p/kg and topping at 432p/kg for D Bennett, Uttoxeter at 49.5kg and M & D Doody 47kg at 426p/kg and E J Taylor & Son 48kg at 425p/kg with MFH Farming 50kg at 416p/kg. Weight and meat 390-400p/kg. Grass lambs 350-364p/kg.

In the lump today export lambs to £184 for 45kg from Messrs Wadland with D Bennett £180 and £183 at 43 and 45kg. Plenty of Export lambs today still breaking past £155.

Heavies magnificent and topping at £246 at 62kg from K Attfield with DS & LE Wadland 61kg at £243 and MFH Farming 59kg at £241.50. E Taylor £240 and Messrs Gregory £238 & £239!!

Hopefully the weather changes and holidayers return soon. Those we cannot determine, what we as an industry can control is the provision of lambs that suit the current trading situations and present fully finished lambs to kill.

Almost fire emoji worthy the trade today. A good yarding of purely farmers Ewes met a rip roaring trade. Major firms flying but smaller firms on limited orders as the same shortage of Ewe demand mirrors the lambs.

Best Ewes today a real trade and topping at £300 and £290 for DW Morley with pure Texels ahead of M&D Doody at £250 for first cross and WJ Pearson Son £248. Plenty of heavy white faced Ewes £226 and over. Suffolks to £222 for T Wheeler & Sons and £218 for Lime Tree Farming. MM Clarke & Sons £216 and heavy Suffolks all past £210. Medium Ewes without fat remain very dear and wanted throughout with plenty trading towards £6 dwkg. Fat a discount throughout and the dry weather seemingly making fit ewes fat. Mules to a massive £198 for Scotch Mules from J Baker & Sons with NCM to £195 for HS Underwood & Son and Hyde Lane Farms. Mules in general £160 plus unless very fat.

Ewes wanted weekly with volume buyers seeing genuine Farmers Ewes.
