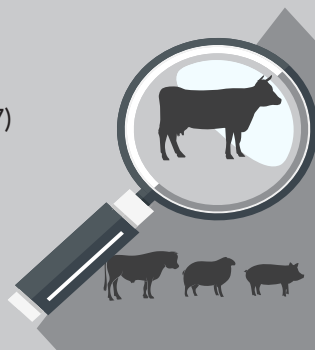

WELFARE STATEMENT

Following a meeting with Warwickshire Trading Standards & the FSA on Monday we have been asked to highlight the Welfare Issues being reported from the Abattoirs regarding Cull Ewes. These mainly relate to MASTITIS & LAMENESS. Condition Score i.e being very thin.

Please remember that an animal must be fit for the intended journey, it should not be ill, injured or severely lame i.e. must be full weight bearing.

These sheep are being rejected at abattoirs around the Country

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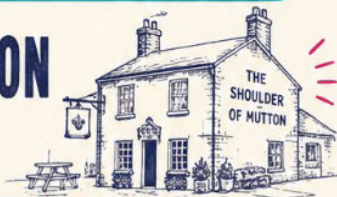

Prime Cattle -

Trade showing signs of brightening in places however end user sales still reported as slow. Customers at ringside for all types, however there is increased demand for untested feeding types of both cows and clean cattle.

Prime Steers -

An extreme Limousin steer from PC Amor selling to a roaring 400p/kg, with heavyweights from JD Stephens selling to 336p/kg.

Top grossing steers to £2384 from PC Amor, with JD Stephens to £2297 and £2157.

Prime Bulls -

Another bumper yarding of bulls saw PC Amor topping with Hereford x Salers to 360p/kg with Simmentals to 340p/kg.

Dairy type bulls trading 320-330p/kg for Native x dairy types.

Top grossing bulls sold to Meadow Farm with heavyweight Blues to £2689 with PM Wilks selling Blues to £2624.

Cows -

A super British Blue cow from Jane Gilbert sold to 300p/kg or £2328. Meated cows generally 240-260p/kg with plainer sorts considerably less.

Lambs;

A more buoyant trade for the meat but lean lambs as is the case nationally worth more in the Stores throughout. An SQQ of 337p/kg about the dearest in the land. The meat chased and wanted the lean lambs with little enquiry.

Export lambs hard placed at the moment with mainland Europe even hotter than the Midlands. Best sorts though to 396p/kg at 44.5kg for DS & LE Wadland with MJ Woodward 43kg at 395p/kg and 39kg at 395p/kg. Meat Lambs trading 340p/kg plus with first cross 330p/kg plus and lean lambs 300p/kg to 310p/kg. Weight easiest sold and twice as many accounts on weight than on Exports. Weight meat and shape from Nigel and Harry Redfern seeing 57kg at 395p/kg with A Williams 46kg at 391p/kg and A Morris, Hinkley 387p/kg. Weight wanted throughout. 47kg plus the easiest sold and meat best rewarded. Again lean lambs hard placed. Meat with weight generally trading 340p/kg and over.

An all in avg of £157 a fast return.

Export Hogs to £176 at 44.5kg from DS & LE Wadland with £170 at 43kg for MJ Woodward and A Morris with Dutch Spotted at £164 for 44kg. Messrs Wadland 42 and 44kg at £162. Export lambs still regularly £158 plus if meat.

Heavies still blasting past £200 and a top today for new customer £226 at 64kg with Nigel Redfern 57kg at £225. Mark Peebles £223 at 65kg and DS & LE Wadland £220.

Meat key. Lean lambs hard to place with Abbatoirs finding it hard to find customer for lean lambs anywhere.

A strong run of ewe lambs from Clopton Orchard Farm saw Suffolks to £171 with the same stable to £161, £158 and £146.

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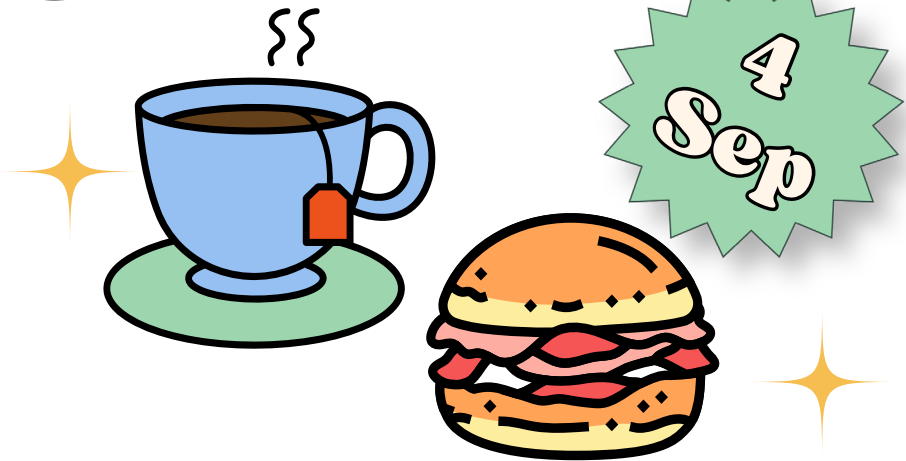
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
